## Camp Staff

### Michelle Cheatham:

Coach Cheatham is entering her 9th season as a coach here at UTSA and first season as head coach. During her eight seasons, UTSA has produced a total of 29 all-conference selections, including 12 first team, 3 NFCA All-Region picks, three Southland Conference Freshman of the Year, and a Southland Utility Player of the Year. She was a graduate of UTSA and played from 1999-2002 for the Roadrunners under head coach Corrie Hill. Coach Cheatham still appears on eight of the school's career charts including putouts, walks, RBIs, home runs, extra base hits, hits and doubles.

### Jessica Rogers

Coach Rogers is in her first season at UTSA formerly coaching at Idaho State for the past three seasons. While with the Bengals, Rogers coached 17 All-Big Sky performers, including two Big Sky Player of the Year honorees and a Freshman of the Year winner. In her last season Idaho State claimed their first Big Sky regular season title. As a player, Rogers rewrote the UTSA and SLC record books and was named ESPN The Magazine Academic All-American and Southland Student-Athlete of the Year three times.

- UTSA has grown from 18,000 to more than 30,000 students since 2000
- 2014 is the Roadrunners first year competing in Conference USA.
